RESTORATION ORDER

WHEREAS the recognition was granted to the institution namely "Mehmuda Shikshan & Mahila Gramin Vikas Bahuddeshiya Sanstha, Survey No.78, Vill- Godhni, Tal/Dist-Nagpur, Maharashtra for B.Ed. programme of one year duration vide Order No. WRC/2-32/65/2004/7388 dated 26.10.2004 with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014 the Revised Recognition Order issued to the institution vide order No. WRC/APW00773/123107/2015/141872-878 dated 31.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. Programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2015-2016.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by the WRC in its 387th Meeting held on June 9-10, 2023 and the Committee decided as under:-

"The original file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and in continuation of decision recorded in the minutes of 255th Meeting of WRC held on June 22-24, 2016, the Committee observed as under:-"

- I. As per decision in 255th Meeting, show cause notice was issued to the institution on 28.03.2017.
- II. Institution submitted reply vide letter dated 17.04.2017 received in WRC on 20.04.2017.
- III. Vide letter dated 17.02.2019 received in WRC on 21.02.2019, the institution has requested for reduction of intake from **two units to one unit** along with an undertaking on an affidavit.
- IV. Vide letters dated 15.04.2023 received in WRC on 26.04.2023 and 17.04.2023 received in WRC on 02.05.2023, the institution has requested for change of the institution name from Mehmuda Shikshan & Mahila Gramin Vikas Bahuddeshiya Sanstha to **Mehmuda Shikshan & Mahila Gramin Vikas Bahuddeshiya Sanstha's Central India Women's College of Education.**
- V. The institution is deficient on the following grounds:

- Original approved faculty list is not submitted by the institution.
- Copy of appointment orders, experience certificates and marksheets/ certificates regarding educational qualifications in r/o the faculty members not submitted.
- As per staff list, faculty at S.No3, 5, 6 & 7 are mentioned as 'not approved'.
- As per staff list, mode of appointment is mentioned as 'Appointed on temporary basis for the post of Principal and Assistant Professor for the academic year 2015-2016'.
- Faculty at S.No.1 does not possess Post graduate degree in Music/Dance/ Theatre Arts
- Faculty for Health and Physical Education and Fine Arts not appointed.
- Notarized copy of Land Use Certificate dated 29.01.2009 issued by the Tahsildar, Nagpur (Rural) submitted by the institution with Survey No.78, Diverted area: 2550 sq.mts. Land area is not sufficient for running B.Ed. and M.Ed. course."

In view of the above, the Committee decided as under:-

- I. Reduction of B.Ed. intake from 100 (two units) to 50 (one unit) be permitted in the address mentioned in the revised recognition order dated 31.05.2015 from the date of issue of letter with a copy endorsed to the State Government and Affiliating Body and others concerned and the same shall be uploaded on the NCTE web portal.
- II. Show Cause Notice prior to withdrawal of recognition be issued to the institution u/s 17 of the NCTE Act on the above mentioned points. The institution shall submit a reply accompanied by an original affidavit within 15 days from the date of issue of show cause notice failing which the WRC will take a decision as deemed fit as per the provisions contained in the NCTE Act and Regulations. A copy of show cause notice be endorsed to the State Government and Affiliating Body.
- III. Proposal for change of name of institution shall be considered after compliance regarding fulfilment of above mentioned points."

Accordingly, Order for **reduction intake** was issued to the institution vide order No. WRC/APW00773/ 123107/B.ED./MH/387TH/2023 /223513- 223515 dated **07.07.2023** and **Show Cause Notice** was issued to the institution on **07.07.2023** and reply received in response to SCN on 06.07.2023 on the basis of minutes uploaded on NCTE website.

4. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in the 402nd Meeting held on 27th March 2024 and the Committee has decided the following:-

"The original file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee decides as under:

Final Show Cause Notice under Section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 prior to withdrawal of recognition be issued to the institution on the following grounds:

- i. *Original faculty list approved by the affiliating body for the approved intake in light of NCTE Norms and Regulations for B.Ed. and other recognised courses is to be submitted.*
- ii. *Land area as per copy of Land Use Certificate dated 29.01.2009 submitted by the institution is not sufficient for running B.Ed. and M.Ed. course.*
- iii. *The institution is required to submit certified copy of legally valid land documents of all the teacher education programmes being run by the institution, land use certificate, Mutation certificate, non-encumbrance certificate, approved building plan, site plan showing location of building as per land and revenue records, building safety certificate as per National Building Code compliant with NDMA guidelines, fire safety certificate, building completion certificate issued by competent authorities of the State Govt.*
- iv. *Acquiring of extra land by the institution after grant of recognition for B.Ed. Course is not permissible.*

The institution shall submit a reply within 15 days from the date of issuance of Final Show Cause Notice.”

Accordingly, the **Final Show Cause Notice** issued to the institution on dated **12.04.2024** and the institution has submitted reply in response of Final Show Cause Notice on 02.05.2024.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by the WRC in its 408th (Part-I) Meeting held on June 12th-14th November, 2024 and the Committee decided as under:-

“The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

The Committee noted that ample opportunities have been provided vide WRC Show Cause Notice dated 07.07.2023, Final Show Cause Notice dated 12.04.2024 to the institution for providing the requisite documents as per the NCTE Regulations, Norms and Standards However, the institution has not complied the deficiencies as detailed below:

- a) *The institution has not appointed Principal/ Head of Department. The institution has appointed only 02 Assistant Professors instead of 04 for B.Ed. Course as required under NCTE Norms.*
- b) *As per Clause 11 of the letter no. 2887 dated 17.04.2017 the receiver of the land will make an agreement and include in it above mention terms and conditions in a prescribe form 13 under rule 42 of Maharashtra Land Revenue (Disposal of Govt.*

- c) The institution has submitted Possession Receipt executed by the Government of Maharashtra Revenue Department through Tahasildar Nagpur (Rural).

 - e) Building plan of the institution is not readable and the same is not approved by competent authority of State Govt.

 - g) Building Completion Certificate not approved from the land Revenue authority of State Govt.

 - j) As per NCTE Norms and Standards for B.Ed. Course, the institution required 2000 Sq. mtrs. built up area and 3000 Sq. mtr. Land area. The institution is conducting 2 units of B.Ed. and one unit of M.Ed. Hence it requires $3000+500= 3500$ Sq. mtrs. land area. However, it has 2550 Sq. mtrs. land area.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that the recognition granted for B.Ed. course to the institution be withdrawn with effect from the end of the academic session next following the date of communication of the withdrawal order.”

Accordingly, **Withdrawal Order** vide No NCTE/WRC/APW00773/123107/B.Ed./408th (Part-I)/MH/2024/77-85 was issued to the institution on **17.12.2024**.

6. AND WHEREAS, the institution filled an **Appeal** against the Withdrawal Order dated 17.12.2024 the appellate authority passes an Order dated 12.03.2025 the Appeal Committee of the Council decision as under.

"The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

- (i) Recognition was granted for B.Ed. Course with annual intake of 100 vide order dated 26.10.2002 followed by Revised order dated 31.05.2015 for compliance of conditions mentioned therein.
- (ii) Show Cause Notice dated 28.03.2017 was issued to the institution.
- (iii) Reduction of B.Ed. intake from 100 to 50 permitted by WRC in 387th meeting was issued vide order dated 07.07.2023 along with Show Cause Notice dated 07.07.2023 for compliance of deficiencies mentioned therein.
- (iv) Permission granted by WRC in its 399th meeting for change of name of institution was issued vide order dated 16.01.2024.
- (v) Final Show Cause Notice was issued dated 12.04.2024 to the institution of which the institution submitted reply vide letter dated 02.05.2024 received on 13.05.2024.
- (vi) Matter was considered by WRC in its 408th meeting and committee found that the institution is deficient on the grounds of Final Show Cause Notice. And Committee decided to withdraw recognition for B.Ed. Course on the deficiencies mentioned therein vide order dated 17.12.2024,
- (vii) Appeal preferred by the institution against withdrawal order and Appellate Authority issued order dated 12.03.2025 and concluded to set aside the impugned order dated 17.12.2024 of WRC NCTE with the direction to revisit the case in totality and also to check that the institution fulfil all the criteria of norms & standards for the land & building and if needed the WRC may also conduct the inspection of the institution to verify the infrastructural & instructional facilities as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, guidelines and amendments issued from time to time, and decision taken accordingly. The Appellant institution is directed to forward to the WRC the documents submitted in appeal within 15 days from the receipt of order of the Appeal and after receipt of the same the WRC to take further necessary action as per direction given in appeal order."

to ascertain and scrutinize all the essential documents and at the time of verification, VT shall also check/verify list year-wise, website and Fire Safety Certificate so as to assess institution's preparedness for running the course as per provision of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

- (ix) Before implementation of decision of 428th meeting of WRC, the institution being aggrieved filed case W.P.(C) 9962/2025 & CM APPL. 41429/2025 in Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and Hon'ble Court passed order dated 17.07.2025 with a direction to "respondent no.2/WRC to issue order of restoration of recognition of B.Ed. Course for 100 seats (Two Basic Units) of the petitioner's institute and to update the status of the petitioner's institute as a recognized institution on its website and necessary communication be also sent to the affiliating university as well as concerned department of the State Government. These directions be complied with within a period of 10 days from today."

In view of the above, the Committee decided that in pursuance of directions issued vide order dated 17.07.2025 of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, recognition for B.Ed. course is restored with a copy endorsed to institution and all concerned, and status of institution as recognized be reflected on the NCTE website.

Further the Committee decided that as per decision taken by Appellate Authority vide order dated 12.03.2025 and subsequent decision of 428th WRC meeting, Visiting Team be constituted in respect of institution for verification of infrastructural and instructional facilities as per NCTE norms and regulations. After receipt of Visiting Team Report, the same shall be considered by WRC."

10. NOW, THEREFORE, the Western-Regional Committee hereby restore recognition of "Mehmuda Shikshan & Mahila Gramin Vikas Bahuddeshiya Sanstha's Central India Women's College of Education, Survey No.78, Vill-Godhani, Street- Godhani road, Tal/Dist-Nagpur, Maharashtra- 441123 for **B.Ed.** programme of two year duration with an annual intake of 100 Students (Two basic unit).
